

## Ice Cream Template

### Step 1



Cut out the templates. If you don't want a flake in your ice cream, just chop it off!

### Step 2

I have a potstand with a diamond pattern which seemed perfect for a waffle cone, so I rubbed brown ink on it and stamped it on my cone.

### Step 3

I sponged ink on to the edges of my ice cream, and also on the edges of my cone.



### Step 4

If you are adding a flake, put it into position and mark where you want it to stick in the ice cream. I have drawn squiggly lines on my flake and inked the edges to make it more realistic.



Cut a slit for the flake to slide into.

### Step 5



Stick the cornet on and then the ice cream and flake.

Fold the back piece on the score line, and add adhesive above it. Stick your front and back piece together.



### Step 6





I brushed glue on my ice cream and poured micro beads over it.  
Use your imagination for what sauces and toppings you could add!
