

Step 1




Cut out your envelope, and fold the flaps in as shown. Add adhesive to them.

Step 2



Carefully fold the bottom up to adhere to your flaps.

Step 3



Print off the inside PDF onto paper. I have given you a lighter version you can use as is.

Step 4




Most printers will not print to the edge, but you can just follow the line with your scissors to the edge. Just cut the vertical line.

Step 5



Fold along the horizontal lines.

Step 6



Now make those folds concertina folds, the first one folding the paper up behind as shown above.

Step 7



If your printer didn't print the bottom line and you haven't cut it yet, it will now stick out from the rest. Trim it to size now.

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Step 8




Add adhesive to the back of your folded paper. The front piece open end is at the top, the back piece open end is at the bottom. Add the adhesive to the top half of the back.

Step 9



Carefully put it into the envelope, holding that top half with the adhesive away from the envelope until it is in place. Tuck it in down to the bottom.

Step 10



Once in place you can take your fingers out and let it stick to the envelope.

Step 11



Put adhesive on the paper that is showing behind the dip in the envelope and add your heart to it, making sure it is tightly in the cut out and not above the fold of the envelope flap.

Step 12



Once it is dry you can pull it out and write your message.
